

Components of the Downtown Partnership Proposal Project

1. Map that describes your vision of the downtown area of Mansfield, Connecticut.
 - ◆ Map should be drawn to scale.
 - ◆ Streets, parking, building sizes and sidewalks should be to town code.
2. Written Defense that explains the logic behind your map design.
 - ◆ Why did you plan the project as you did?
 - ◆ Written defense should include the following key points:
 - i. How did the survey influence your decisions?
 - ii. What geological factors were taken into consideration in your design?
 - iii. How does your plan account for erosion that may take place within this map?
 - iv. What has your group decided to do with any stonewalls that may lie within the project area?
 - v. Include a list of construction materials that will be used in this building project that are a product of the earth (concrete, sand, etc.)
 - vi. Address any other impacts that you feel important to your map (i.e. noise pollution, traffic, etc.)
3. Survey that asks the people of your community their vision of downtown Mansfield.
 - ◆ Think about what you really want in you downtown. Tailor your survey to your views.
 - ◆ Use the survey examples to help you with ideas in creating your survey.
